

## 【校內最新防疫因應措施】

因應疫情最新發展，防疫小組提醒全校師生同仁配合下列防疫事項：

1. 全校自5月16日(一)起暫停實體授課，遠距教學至本學期結束。
2. 自5月8日起，僅同住家人或室友確診才需匡列為密切接觸者，並完成3 + 4天居家隔離後，第8天快篩陰性便得返校。未被匡列之其他接觸者可正常上課上班，但仍須做好個人防護，有症狀自行請假並進行快篩。
3. 因與家人及室友密切接觸而隔離之教職員生外，其餘之前已匡列為密切接觸者之個案，自5月8日起解除隔離後返校上課上班。
4. 確診者發病2天內，教職員生有未戴口罩與確診者近距離接觸超過15分鐘以上者，可請3天防疫假，防疫假期間不得入校。
5. 確診者與國外入境者完成7天隔離後，建議於自主健康管理期間不入校園；如須進入校園應遵守自我健康管理規範，配戴口罩、維持社交距離，並避免群聚活動與集會。
6. 各校區宿舍或館舍，基於風險及管理考量，得制定相關規範。

### Epidemic Prevention Announcement

1. All in-person classes will shift to remote learning from May 16 to the end of this semester.
2. Only students and faculty who live in the same household or dormitory with a covid-19 infected person will have to isolation / quarantine for 3+4 days and come back to campus on the 8th day with having a negative test. Others who do not be identified as close contacts can study and work in campus as usual but still need to follow the IUP principle and take a sick leave if necessary.
3. Except for those who live in the same household or dormitory with a covid-19 infected person, student and faculty who are identified as close contacts before and under isolation / quarantine currently can be released and come back to campus from May 8.
4. Students and faculty who never wear masks and have been exposed to a covid-19 infected person over 15 minutes within two days before his or her first symptom appearance can ask for a 3-day disease prevention leave. Those who take a disease prevention leave cannot go to campus.
5. In response to the latest pandemic situation, we suggest that students and faculty who are infected or return to Taiwan from foreign countries cannot come back to the campus in the period of self-health management. If it is necessary, the students or faculty must follow the guideline of self-health management, wear masks, maintain a social distance, avoid crowded place and meeting.
6. Dormitories and buildings can have other regulations according to its risk assessment.
