"I have started my research journey at NYCU in 2019 with the passion of "How things are connected, how the mobile devices can communicate even from one side to another side of the world". I have been on this passion since owning the first smartphone, Samsung Galaxy S, in 2010. I was a high school student at that time. I am researching 5G Multi-Access Edge Computing (MEC), Mobile Network at Network, and Mobile System (NEMS) led by Professor Chi-Yu Li. Before that, I received a Master's degree in EECS IGP from NYCU in 2021. I also had published a conference paper at IEEE 8th World Forum on Internet of Things, 2021 during my Master's study. I worked at Pegatron Corporation in Taipei as a 5G MEC R&D engineer for almost one year before pursuing a Ph.D. degree at NYCU. During my work and study, I have many chances to work and study with diverse

cultures from different countries. I am proud that I can share my story in Taiwan with you guys."



Research Highlights

It is our pleasure to demonstrate the research achievement. NYCU provides valuable resources for the world.



The international collaborative study by the researchers in the Institute of Clinical Medicine at NYCU and the National Institute of Health (NIH) in the United States measured various common metals in human serum and found that six metals were related to the presence of gallstones and twelve metals were related to gallbladder cancer. Extremely high or low concentrations of metals may associate with cancer development. <u>To read more...</u>


