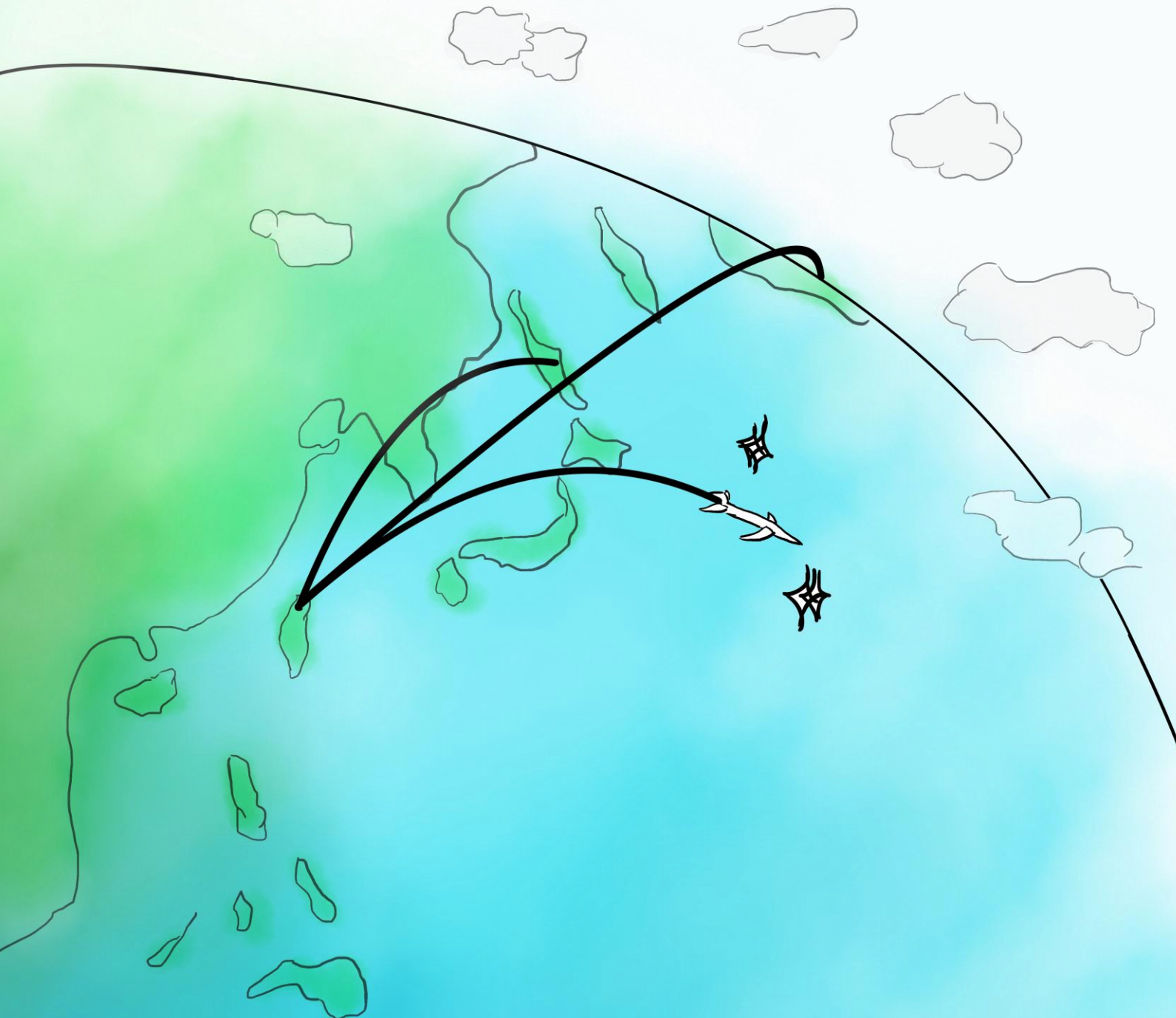

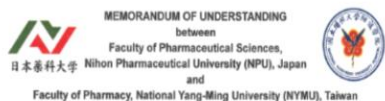

- Exchange of academic materials and other information.

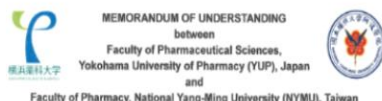

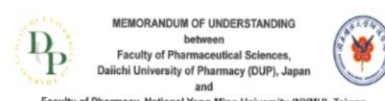

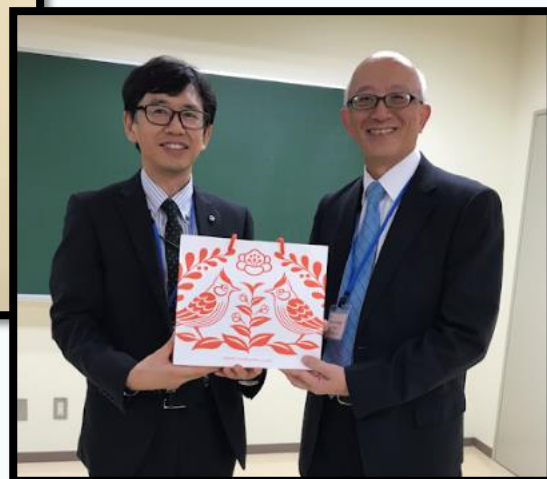
