



## ShanghaiRanking's Academic Ranking of World Universities 2023

## NYCU is ranked 425th, showing stability and progress

The ShanghaiRanking's Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) annually ranks over 2,500 universities worldwide and releases rankings for the top 1,000 universities. In the latest ranking published on August 15th, NYCU improved its position, moving up from 432<sup>nd</sup> place last year to 425<sup>th</sup> place in the global rankings. This year, Taiwan has five universities in the top 500, namely National Taiwan University (ranked 222<sup>nd</sup>), China Medical University (ranked 251<sup>st</sup>), National Cheng Kung University (ranked 357<sup>th</sup>), National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (ranked 425<sup>th</sup>), and National Tsing Hua University (ranked 479<sup>th</sup>).

Unlike the QS and THE rankings, the ARWU ranking places a strong emphasis on top-tier academic research achievements and awards. The evaluation criteria mostly focus on totals without considering the size of the institution or the distribution of disciplines. The ARWU ranking uses six indicators, which include award-winning alumni (10%), award-winning faculty (20%), highly cited researchers (20%), papers in Nature and Science (20%), papers indexed in Science Citation Index-Expanded and Social Science Citation Index (20%), and per capita performance (10%).
