

<u>U.S.News 2024-2025 Best Global Universities Rankings</u> NYCU ranked in 25 subjects, with 3 subjects ranking 1st domestically

On June 25, US News & World Report released the latest 2024-2025 edition of the Best Global Universities Rankings and subject rankings. This year's rankings included a total of 2,271 universities from 104 countries, ultimately listing the top 2,250 universities. Among the 43 subject rankings announced this year, our university ranked in 25 subjects, an increase of 7 subjects from the previous year (see Table 2). The number of subjects ranked is second only to NTU among domestic universities.

This year, our university's newly ranked subjects include Artificial Intelligence, Biology and Biochemistry, Energy and Fuels, Environment/Ecology, Infectious Diseases, Public, Environmental and Occupational Health, and Social Sciences and Public Health, adding a total of 7 new subjects.

Additionally, three subjects performed outstandingly, continue to hold the top position in Taiwan:

- Cardiology and Cardiovascular System, ranked 208th globally and first nationally, with our university being the only domestic institution ranked in this subject.
- Optics, ranked 117th globally and first nationally.
- Radiology, Nuclear Medicine and Medical Imaging, ranked 230th globally and first nationally.
