THE's 2024 Young University Rankings NYCU ranks 49th globally and 1st domestically

Times Higher Education (THE) ranks the world's best universities established within the last 50 years. On May 14th, THE released the latest "Young University Rankings 2024". In 2024, a total of 673 schools were ranked, higher than the 605 in 2023. Eighteen universities from Taiwan made the list, with NYCU ranking 1st domestically and 49th globally, improving by 48 places from last year (Table 1).

The ranking uses the same methodology as the World University Rankings, but the weighting has been recalibrated to reflect the mission and profile of younger universities. The evaluation indicators are divided into five aspects: teaching (29.5%), research environment (29%), research quality (30%), international outlook (7.5%), and industry income (4%), to measure all core tasks of research universities: teaching, research, knowledge transfer, and international outlook.

THE's 2024 University Impact Rankings NYCU ranks 50th globally and 2nd domestically




Figure 1 Global and domestic number of participating schools

The Times Higher Education (THE) World University Impact Rankings evaluate universities based on the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) set by the United Nations. On June 12, THE released the latest "Impact Rankings 2024," which included a total of 2,152 universities from 125 countries and regions. Taiwan had 51 universities featured in the rankings. The universities in Taiwan participated most frequently in the following ranking categories: 39 universities were listed for SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production), followed by 37 universities each for SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), and SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure) (Figure 1).

In 2024, NYCU ranked 50th globally and second nationally, an improvement of 33 places from last year. The university participated in the Impact Rankings with 11 SDGs, with five SDGs placing in the top 100. The top three highest-scoring SDGs were SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure), ranked 38th globally, SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-being), ranked 27th globally, and SDG 16 (Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions), ranked 29th globally. The distribution of SDG rankings among domestic universities is detailed in the figure 2. In response to climate change and the transition to a sustainable economy, NYCU continues to promote sustainable education by developing strategies for cultivating sustainable talent, integrating sustainability concepts into courses and research, enhancing the awareness of sustainability goals among faculty and students, and incorporating sustainable development goals into the university's vision. This commitment aims to create a friendly campus environment and demonstrate the university's sustainable development capabilities.





<u>U.S.News 2024-2025 Best Global Universities Rankings</u> NYCU ranked in 25 subjects, with 3 subjects ranking 1st domestically

On June 25, US News & World Report released the latest 2024-2025 edition of the Best Global Universities Rankings and subject rankings. This year's rankings included a total of 2,271 universities from 104 countries, ultimately listing the top 2,250 universities. Among the 43 subject rankings announced this year, our university ranked in 25 subjects, an increase of 7 subjects from the previous year (see Table 2). The number of subjects ranked is second only to NTU among domestic universities.

This year, our university's newly ranked subjects include Artificial Intelligence, Biology and Biochemistry, Energy and Fuels, Environment/Ecology, Infectious Diseases, Public, Environmental and Occupational Health, and Social Sciences and Public Health, adding a total of 7 new subjects.

Additionally, three subjects performed outstandingly, continue to hold the top position in Taiwan:

- Cardiology and Cardiovascular System, ranked 208th globally and first nationally, with our university being the only domestic institution ranked in this subject.
- Optics, ranked 117th globally and first nationally.
- Radiology, Nuclear Medicine and Medical Imaging, ranked 230th globally and first nationally.



2025 QS World University Rankings - Citations per Faculty NYCU Ranks 1st Domestically

The UK Higher Education Survey Center (Quacquarelli Symonds, QS) announced the "2025 QS World University Rankings" this June. A total of 1,503 schools made the list for 2025, an increase from 1,499 in 2024. Twenty-seven universities and colleges from Taiwan were included, with NYCU ranking 219th globally and 4th nationally. Notably, NYCU achieved the highest national rank in the "Citations per Faculty" metric, which evaluates the impact of research output. This indicator uses the Scopus database to calculate the number of citations per faculty member for papers published over the past five years (2018-2022) and cited over the past six years (2018-2023), excluding self-citations.

2024 Global Views Magazine Taiwan Best University Rankings NYCU Recognized as a Leader in the "Information and Communications Technology" Field

The "Global Views" Taiwan Best University Rankings 2024 were announced on July 2nd, with our university ranking 3rd among comprehensive universities, the same as last year. Additionally, it was recognized as the leader in the "Information and Communication Technology" field. The survey evaluated universities based on six major aspects, encompassing a total of 45 detailed indicators: social reputation (20%), with 11 indicators; academic achievement (20%), with 7 indicators; teaching performance (16%), with 8 indicators; degree of internationalization (15%), with 8 indicators; industry-academia performance (19%), with 7 indicators; and financial indicators (10%), with 4 indicators. Among the 45 detailed indicators, NYCU secured first place in 6 categories: SDG impact, enrollment rate, the proportion of income from sources other than tuition fees, the average amount of academic research project funding per faculty member, the weighted ratio of full-time faculty receiving awards/honors, and the number of Taiwan patents.

Authorization Function of the Institutional Research Data Visualization Platform Officially Launched

The NYCU Office of Data Analytics and Research Center has developed a "University Research Data Visualization Platform" to integrate campus single sign-on access and various visualization dashboards developed on different platforms. Since its official launch in March, the platform has accumulated approximately 500 clicks. To enhance the platform's stability, the center has recently completed a migration of the visualization platform and continues to improve system functionalities and dashboard integration.

The platform includes existing dashboards for categories such as global university rankings, sustainability indicators, campus open data statistics, industry-academia cooperation projects and funding, tailored admissions support data, graduate tracking surveys, and academic performance tracking. In response to business unit needs, new dashboards have been added, including one for tracking the performance of economically disadvantaged students and another for providing information on the highest educational qualifications of international students. These new features are intended for use by the Office of Student Affairs and the Office of International Affairs.

The platform offers dashboard categories for all faculty, staff, and students to access, including: global university rankings, sustainability indicators, and campus open data statistics. Other categories are provided with different access permissions based on specific business needs. To increase dashboard utilization and meet practical needs, the platform has recently added an "Authorization" feature (see figure 3), allowing users with viewing permissions (e.g., department heads) to grant access to other internal users (e.g., departmental assistants).

To use the authorization feature, please log in to the university's single sign-on portal and navigate to: NYCU\Other\University Research Data Visualization Dashboard Platform. We encourage you to make full use of the platform.
