NYCU ranks 424th globally and 3rd nationally in 2025 THE World University Rankings

On October 9, 2024, the Times Higher Education (THE) announced the 2025 World University Rankings. National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU) ranked 424th globally, dropping 21 places from the previous year, but it remains the third-highest-ranked university in Taiwan.

This year, 2,092 universities from 115 countries and regions made it to the rankings, an increase of 188 universities compared to the previous year (1,904). Taiwan had 47 universities on the list, two more than last year. Among the top 10 universities in Taiwan, except for National Taiwan University (NTU) dropping 20 places, the rankings for the other institutions remained stable.


THE World University Rankings (2/2)

NTU remains the top-ranked university in Taiwan, ranking 172nd globally. China Medical University is second in Taiwan, ranking 321st globally, followed by NYCU at 424th. National Tsing Hua University is 431st globally and fourth in Taiwan. Other Taiwanese universities include National Taiwan University of Science and Technology (436th globally), Asia University (455th), Taipei Medical University (462nd), National Yunlin University of Science and Technology (511th), National Cheng Kung University (587th), and National Taiwan Normal University (595th).

The 2025 THE World University Rankings are based on 18 evaluation indicators, covering five key areas: Teaching (29.5%), Research Environment (29%), Research Quality (30%), Industry (4%), and International Outlook (7.5%).

Compared to the global average, NYCU performed particularly well in the "Industry" indicator, ranking 35th globally with a score of 99.9. For "Research Quality," NYCU ranked 986th globally, with improved citation impact, research intensity, excellence, and research influence compared to last year. However, the scores for "Research Quality," "Teaching," and "International Outlook" slightly declined, indicating areas for continued improvement.
