THE Rankings:

2025 THE Interdisciplinary Science Rankings

On November 21, 2024, THE released its first-ever **2025 Interdisciplinary Science Rankings (ISR)**, evaluating universities worldwide on their performance in interdisciplinary scientific research. The ISR methodology is based on three pillars: inputs (19%), process (16%), and outputs (65%). Each pillar represents research project stages. These pillars are assessed through 11 metrics in total.

The 2025 rankings focus exclusively on interdisciplinary research within the fields of Computer Science, Engineering, Life Sciences, and Physical Sciences. A total of 749 universities from 92 countries and regions made it into the rankings. Taiwan has 13 universities on the list, with National Taiwan University (NTU) achieving the highest global ranking at 21st place.
