To promote AI-driven digital transformation, foster an innovative campus environment, and cultivate interdisciplinary talent, National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU) held the “114th Academic Year Leadership Gathering and AI Consensus Camp” on August 25 at the International Conference Hall, Hao-Ran Library, Guangfu Campus. The event brought together university executives and faculty to discuss strategies for building a campus-wide AI ecosystem and strengthening consensus on AI transformation and talent cultivation.

The program opened with the President’s address, highlighting a shared vision for a smart campus, followed by a keynote speech from C. S. Bien, General Manager of Microsoft Taiwan, who shared insights on AI applications in education, research, and industry innovation.

The event concluded with a panel discussion led by Secretary-General Chin-Wu Tsai and closing remarks from the President. Through this exchange between university leaders and industry experts, NYCU reaffirmed its commitment to advancing smart campus development and AI innovation, setting a new benchmark for digital transformation in higher education.
