


tool= scanner_a sectional machine





accumulated pattern


Vertical bar distribution tells in which angle that the box rotated. And the gradual variety indicates subtle movement in different time space.

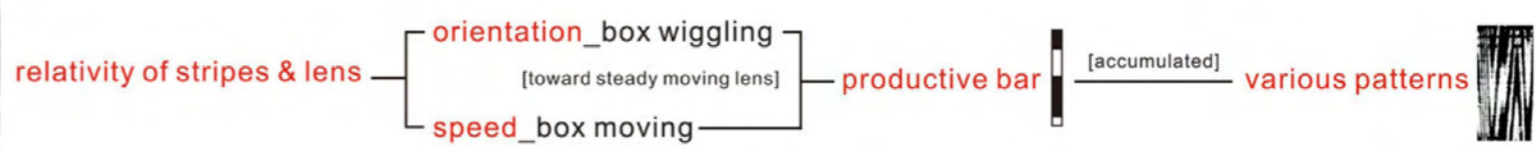
